

## Negotiations Update #7 – February 12, 2010

Your Negotiations Team met for face to face talks with the Company this week (February 9-11, 2010) in Dallas. We did a crew lounge site in DFW on February 8<sup>th</sup> and were able to speak with many members about our negotiations. At the conclusion of negotiations, we were promptly stuck, as a result of the record breaking snow storm in DFW.

While we were not able to reach any tentative agreements during this session, we were able to engage in some meaningful dialogue about Section 19 Training. We also passed proposals on EAP (new section), Section 28 Physical Exams and Section 30 International .
