

Negotiations Update #9

March 19, 2010

Dear AFA Member,

Your Negotiations Team met with the Company for face to face talks, this week in LAX. We did a crew lounge sit on Monday March 15th. We met a lot of the LAX based Flight Attendants and got some great feedback.

We are happy to report that we were able to reach a tentative agreement on a new section entitled "Geographic Emergencies and Aircraft Repositioning." This new sections provides guidelines for Flight Attendants who volunteer to participate in the repositioning of aircraft, when necessary, due to naturally occurring events such as hurricanes.

We are very close to reaching a tentative agreement on another new section for "EAP." We are hopeful we can sign off on this section during our next session. Proposals on Section 12 Uniforms, Section 19 Training, Section 26 Safety and Health and Section 28 Physical Examinations were also exchanged during this week's session. AFA is awaiting counterproposals from the Company and will discuss them further during the next session scheduled in DFW on April 12-13, 2010.
